Winners of the above Non-Regular Classes, if otherwise undefeated, compete for Best of Breed.

BEST OF BREED (VARIETY) COMPETITION

The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed Competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which according to their owner's records have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed champions in Best of Breed (Variety) Competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

AWARDS OF MERIT: At the conclusion of Best of Breed, after picking Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Best of Winners, Select Dog and Select Bitch, the Judge, at his/her discretion, may choose up to two (2) Pomeranians for an Award of Merit. Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Best of Winners, and Select Dog/Bitch shall not be eligible for the Award.

BEST FROM THE REGULAR PUPPY CLASSES (FRIDAY): At the conclusion of Best of Breed judging the winners of the Regular Puppy Classes (6-9, 9-12 & Bred-By Exhibitor) compete for Best Puppy, unless Best of Winners is from a puppy class, that entry is automatically Best Puppy.

BEST FROM THE BRED BY EXHIBITOR CLASSES (SATURDAY): At the conclusion of Best of Breed judging, winners of Bred by Exhibitor Adult/Puppy classes compete for Best Bred by Exhibitor. If Best of Winners is from the Bred by Exhibitor class, that entry is automatically Best Bred by Exhibitor.

BEST FROM THE VETERAN CLASSES: During Best of Breed judging, Best Veteran will be selected from the winners of those classes.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES

STUD DOG CLASS - For Stud Dogs and two or more of their Get. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog. The Stud Dog may be entered in one of the Regular Classes or, if a Champion of Record, in Best of Breed competition, but must be entered in the Stud Dog class. The Get must be entered in one of the Regular or Non-Regular Classes or, if a Champion of Record, in Best of Breed competition. The Stud Dog must be shown in the ring with the Get. The class will be judged based on the merits of the Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the dog show rules, AKC policy, or the standard of the breed.

BROOD BITCH CLASS - Same as for Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog & Brood Bitch classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won either of these classes. Stud Dogs & Brood Bitches may be Spayed or Neutered.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION - SATURDAY ONLY

NOVICE CLASS: For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or member show.

OPEN CLASS: For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three first place awards in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show. Juniors which according to their records have completed the requirements to compete in the Open class but whose status is unconfirmed by the American Kennel Club are limited to competing in the Open Class for a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the Junior completed the requirements according to their records.

MASTER CLASS: This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry. You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC, Judges Education Department, 919-233-9767. BE SURE ALL INFORMATION for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on front and back of entry form.

NOTE: SUBSTITUTION OF DOG IN JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP AT THE SHOW(S): There will be an Administration Fee of \$5.00 charged for any substitution of dog in Junior Showmanship at each show. In addition, if the dog originally entered in Jr. Showmanship was an additional entry, and the dog being substituted is not otherwise entered in the show, the Junior Showmanship Only fee applies.
