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NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS - ALL EVENTS

The American Kennel Club Rules and Regulations will govern this Show and Exhibitors must make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany this Show Premium List. The

American Kennel Club will collect the following at every Licensed or Member club event: An AKC Recording and Service Fee of \$4.50 for each entry. An AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 per entry will be required for each dog entered at any 4 & Under 6 Months Puppy and Open Show. All Recording and Event Service Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club. (There is no Recording Fee or Event Service Fee for Junior Showmanship, Sweepstakes, Futurities, Brace/Team, Multi-Dog Classes, or Special Attractions.)

- No Entry will be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Telegraph, e-mail and unsigned entries cannot be accepted and will be returned. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies of Entry Forms without Agreement and Rules on reverse side are NOT ACCEPTABLE. The Club and/or Baray Events assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or the owner's agent. RESPONSIBILITY FOR COMPLETENESS OF ENTRY RESTS SOLELY WITH ENTRANT.
- RETURNED CHECKS DO NOT CONSTITUTE A VALID ENTRY FEE. BaRay Events will add a \$30.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. We will not re-process checks. The exhibitor will be contacted & required to send a money order for the original amount PLUS the \$30.00 NSF fee. Subsequent returned checks from same person may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY BASIS.
- REFUNDS for cancellations due to judge change or cancellations made prior to entries closing will be mailed by the Club to said Exhibitor or Agent AFTER THE SHOW. An administrative fee of \$5.00 will be withheld from all refunds for entries cancelled prior to the closing of entries.
- Females in season are not permitted to compete in Obedience or Rally Trials. If a female is withdrawn from competition because it came into season and the Superintendent is notified no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class in the trial, the Club is required to refund the entry fee. The Clubs may retain a processing fee and must publish this information in the premium. Clubs may determine the documentation, if any that is required to confirm the female is in season. This shall be stated in the premium. Note: No fee is paid to the AKC for females in season who are withdrawn.
- FAX ENTRIES – Fax entries will not be accepted.
- Entry fees shall NOT be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. There is no refund for DUPLICATE ENTRIES or OVERPAYMENTS. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open, or to complete the Show NO REFUND will be made. To find out about any AKC event cancellations call the AKC Event Cancellation Hotline 877-252-3229.
- Please note: Any hotel or motel listed in the premium list is subject to Event Committee Rules. We expect our exhibitors to be responsible guests. A report that an exhibitor at this show has abused hotel or motel property during this weekend may result in disciplinary action. Clubs reserve the right to decline future entries from the offending party in accordance with the provisions of Ch. 11, Sec. 15 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows.
- Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging. Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Superintendent will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class Judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the rings.
- Only dogs eligible for these shows will be admitted into show area. There is no provision for unentered dogs.
- LOSS OR DAMAGE – The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of any accident or misfortune, to either dogs or exhibitors participating in these Shows. The welfare of an Exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the Exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that Exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. Additionally, clubs should include any specific local health requirements; for example proof of rabies vaccination.
- PUBLICATION RIGHTS – By entering this show, all owners, handlers, breeders and kennels agree that all rights to televise, videotape, photograph, advertise, promote and publicize or otherwise exploit this show, or the persons or animals participating in it or the results of the competition before, during or after the event, shall belong solely to The American Kennel Club and their respective assigns, including the use of the names, likenesses or biographical matter of all dogs, owners, handlers, breeders and kennels participating in the show and no such owner, handler, breeder or kennel shall allow any other party to make commercial use of any videotape or photograph of any person or animal participating in this competition.

AWARDS OF MERIT – The judge may give an Award of Merit Rosette offered by the Samoyed Club of Washington State, Inc. at her discretion to the following number of dogs. The number of Rosettes that may be given will be equal to 10% of the number of Specials entered at the time of closing. This number is to be rounded downward (see chart below). The number entered will disregard all absentees & transfers from the classes.

NOTE: Neutered dogs and spayed bitches are allowed to compete in all single entry non-regular classes at independent specialties which do not offer any competitive classes beyond Best of Breed.

Dogs/Bitches must be registered with the AKC. ILP numbers are not acceptable. Entrants must have a Samoyed Club of America Working Dog Title, either WS, WSX or WSXM, or any other AKC performance title (i.e., to include but not be limited to Obedience, Agility or any other AKC performance title event).

Winners of the Above Classes, if otherwise undefeated, compete for Best of Breed.

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed Competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a Championship but whose Championships are unconfirmed. The showing of dogs whose Championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a Championship according to the owners' records.

Non-Regular Classes (Involving Multiple Dog Entries) - Friday Only

Note: Non-regular classes involving multiple entries may be judged before or after Best of Breed. As the judge's decision in these classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog, no one of the dogs making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed by virtue of having won the class.

Stud Dog Class and Brood Bitch Class: Each entry is allowed two get unless otherwise specified. The merits of the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch are not considered in the placement of the entry. It is the quality of the get that forms the basis for the judge's decision. All get must be examined and gaited. The Stud Dog or Brood Bitch must also be examined to determine if there is a condition that would require disqualification or excusal under the Rules, AKC policy or the breed standard. All get must be entered in a regular class in order to be eligible to compete in the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch Class. Handlers of the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch, and all get being exhibited, must wear armbands. Ch. 11, Sec. 8 of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that "a castrated male may be entered as a Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class."

Brace Class: Two Dogs, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in the brace class must have at least one common owner. Dogs do not need to be entered in any other class. Dogs comprising a Brace Class must be named at the time of entry, and full particulars must be given for each dog on individual entry forms. If a dog which is to be part of a Brace is not entered in another class, it must be entered for "Brace Class only." An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as part of a Brace must be marked accordingly in the space provided for additional classes as "Brace Class."

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION - FRIDAY ONLY

NOVICE CLASS: For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class.

OPEN CLASS: For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three first place awards in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show. Juniors which according to their records have completed the requirements to compete in the Open class but whose status is unconfirmed by the American Kennel Club are limited to competing in the Open Class for a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the Junior completed the requirements according to their records.

MASTER CLASS: This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have 10 Best Junior wins with competition. .

NOVICE AND OPEN CLASS DIVIDED: Junior-9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show; Intermediate-12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show; Senior-15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show.

NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry. You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC, Judges Education Department, 919-233-9767. BE SURE ALL INFORMATION for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on front and back of entry form.

NOTE: SUBSTITUTION OF DOG IN JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP AT THE SHOW(S): There will be an Administration Fee of \$5.00 charged for any substitution of dog in Junior Showmanship at each show. In addition, if the dog originally entered in Jr. Showmanship was an additional entry, and the dog being substituted is not otherwise entered in the show, the Junior Showmanship Only fee applies.

SWEEPSTAKES & VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES

SWEEPSTAKES REQUIREMENTS & CLASSIFICATION

To stimulate interest in the showing of promising Samoyeds, a Sweepstakes will be held in conjunction with the Samoyed Club of Washington State, Inc. Specialty. Sweepstakes will be judged prior to the Regular Classes. The Sweepstakes is open to all Samoyeds that are at least 6 months of age & under 18 months of age on the day of the show. Dogs shown in Sweepstakes must also be entered in one of the regular classes at the regular entry fee and on the regular entry form. Indicate your Sweepstakes Class with the age division in the space provided for "Additional Class." Winner of each class will compete for Best in Sweepstakes.

The following classes will be provided for both dogs and bitches:

Puppy, 6 Mos. & Under 9 Mos. • Puppy, 9 Mos. & Under 12 Mos.
Junior, 12 Mos. & Under 18 Mos.

Veteran Sweepstakes will be judged immediately following regular Sweepstakes. Veteran Sweepstakes is open to all Samoyeds that are at least 7 years of age on the day of the show. Dogs shown in Veteran Sweepstakes need not be entered in one of the regular classes or at the regular entry fee. Indicate your Veteran Sweepstakes Class with the age division in the space provided. Neutered dogs & spayed bitches are eligible for Veteran Sweepstakes.

The following classes will be provided for both dogs and bitches.

Veteran, 7 Yrs & Under 10 Yrs • Veteran, 10 Yrs & Under 12 Yrs • Veteran, 12 Yrs & Older

Winners of the Working Sweepstakes classes will compete for Best in Working Sweepstakes & Best of Opposite Sex to Best in Working Sweepstakes. Dogs shown in Working Sweepstakes may be altered. Dogs shown in Working Sweepstakes need not be entered in one of the regular classes at the regular entry fee. Indicate your Working Sweepstakes Class with the division in the space provided.

The following classes will be provided for both dogs and bitches.

Pretitled – (300 points earned in calendar year toward Samoyed Club of America WS title or one qualifying score in any AKC performance event)

Novice – (SCA WS title or any novice/initial AKC performance title; CA, CD, GN, HS, NA, NAJ, NAP, NF, NFP, NJP, BN, OA, & RN)

Intermediate – (SCA WSX title or any intermediate AKC performance title; CAA, GO, HI, OA, OF, OJ, RE & XF)

Advanced – (SCA WSXM title or any advanced AKC performance title; AJX, AX, AXJ, AXP, CAX, CDX, HX, MJP, MX, MXF, MXJ, MXP, OGM, OM, PA, RA, UD, VC, XFP)

Documentation of qualifications for entry must accompany entries.

SPECIAL RECOGNITION

AWARDS OF MERIT: At the discretion of the judge, two Awards of Merit will be awarded. All dogs competing for Best of Breed are eligible for an Award of Merit, except for Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, and Best of Winners.

BEST BRED-BY EXHIBITOR, BEST PUPPY, BEST VETERAN, BEST VETERAN DOG/BITCH AND BEST WORKING SAMOYED (FRIDAY ONLY): Eligibility for Best Bred-by Exhibitor, Best Puppy, Best Veteran, Best Veteran Dog/Bitch and Best Working Samoyed competitions is predicated upon entry into the following class(es) and all divisions of:

- Best Bred-By Exhibitor – the age appropriate Bred-by-Exhibitor class including the Bred-by-Exhibitor Puppy or Bred-by-Exhibitor Adult age divisions
- Best Puppy – any class limited to dogs six months and older and under 12 months of age; 6-9 Puppy, 9-12 Puppy, and Bred-by-Exhibitor Puppy
- Best Veteran & Best Veteran Dog/Bitch – any non-regular Veteran Class
- Best Working Samoyed – any non-regular Working Dog or Bitch Class

For Best Bred-By Exhibitor, the eligibility criteria involving the individual handling the dog applies only to the original class entered and all competition specific to the special attraction. There are no restrictions as to who may handle the dog in any subsequent classes it may become eligible.

Best Veteran & Best Veteran Dog/Bitch: following Best of Breed, the winners of the various Veteran Dog Classes will compete for the Best Veteran Dog and winners of the various Veteran Bitch Classes will compete for Best Veteran Bitch. The Best Veteran Dog and the Best Veteran Bitch then compete for Best Veteran.

NOTE: Best Veteran, Best Puppy or Best Bred By Exhibitor competition will be forgone if the Best of Breed is one of the above.

PARADE OF CHAMPIONS AND TITLEHOLDERS - FRIDAY
