NON-REGULAR CLASSES (INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES)

Note: Non-regular classes involving multiple entries may be judged before or after Best of Breed. As the judge's decision in these classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog, no one of the dogs making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed by virtue of having won the class.

Stud Dog Class and Brood Bitch Class: Each entry is allowed two and not more than four get. The merits of the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch are not considered in the placement of the entry. The quality of the get forms the basis for the judge's decision. All get must be examined and gaited. The Stud Dog or Brood Bitch must also be examined to determine if there is a condition that would require disqualification or excusal under the Rules, AKC policy or the breed standard. All get must be entered in a regular class in order to be eligible to compete in the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch Class. Handlers of the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch, and all get being exhibited, must wear armbands. Ch. 11, Sec. 8 of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that "a castrated male may be entered as a Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class."

Brace Class: Two Dogs, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in the brace class must have at least one common owner. Dogs do not need to be entered in any other class. Dogs comprising a Brace Class must be named at the time of entry, and full particulars must be given for each dog on individual entry forms. If a dog which is to be part of a Brace is not entered in another class, it must be entered for "Brace Class only." An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as part of a Brace must be marked accordingly in the space provided for additional classes as "Brace Class." *Beginning July 2, 2025 dogs & bitches entered in this class, may be spayed or neutered.*

Team Class: Four Dogs, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of four handlers. All dogs competing in the team class must have at least one common owner. Dogs do not need to be entered in any other class. Dogs comprising a Team Class must be named at the time of entry, and full particulars must be given for each dog on individual entry forms. If a dog which is to be part of a Team is not entered in another class, it must be entered for "Team Class only." An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as part of a Team must be marked accordingly in the space provided for additional classes as "Team Class."

In Loving Memory of Cynthia (Cyndi) Dell Morgandell Borzoi & Silken Windhounds

Cynthia (Cyndi) Dell, a beloved member of the sight-hound community and the heart behind Morgandell Borzoi and Silken Windhounds, passed away in November 2024 after a valiant fight with cancer. Just a few months earlier, in August 2024, she also suffered the heartbreaking loss of her husband and partner, Bill Hemby.

Cyndi made her home in Grass Valley, California. Before relocating from Washington State, Cyndi had already earned a well-deserved reputation for her Borzoi. More than just a breeder, Cyndi was a cherished mentor and friend to many in the Borzoi community. She generously shared her knowledge and passion and helped guide newcomers to the breed. Whether she was teaching about structure and movement or helping someone navigate their first dog show, her mentorship left a lasting legacy.

Cyndi was a longtime member and supporter of the Puget Sound Borzoi Club. And, her creative talents extended beyond the show ring. The PSBC logo still in use today features a Borzoi drawn by Cyndi, a lasting tribute to both her artistic skill and her devotion to the breed. Cyndi had a tremendous impact on the world of sight-hounds—and on the lives of those who knew her. Her memory lives on in the dogs she bred and the people she inspired. She is deeply missed

- **NOVICE CLASS:** For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class.
- **OPEN CLASS:** For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three first place awards in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show.
- MASTER CLASS: This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have 10 Best Junior wins with competition.
