### **IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING SHOW SITE / HOTEL**

#### **HOLIDAY INN ROBERTS CENTRE RULES AND REGULATIONS**

1. There shall be no more than four (4) dogs per room. All dogs left unattended in hotel guest rooms must be crated.
2. Group must provide sheets of plastic to place under the crates. UP TO FOUR DOGS WILL BE PERMITTED PER ROOM. ALAC will provide the plastic.
3. Housekeepers will NOT have to service rooms in which dogs are loose and unattended. Moreover, they will be required to report this rules violation to hotel management. A one-time fee of \$75 will be charged for each room in which a dog is housed per stay. Rooms found to house a dog/animal that is not secured in a crate will be charged a higher pet fee. Individual room occupants will be assessed for any damage or destruction to that room including but not limited to damage to sheets, towels, flooring, furniture, carpet etc.
4. Dogs will be bathed in designed areas for dog washing. There will be no grooming of dogs in hotel rooms and no hotel towels will be used for that purpose. Rooms where evidence of dog grooming or bathing in the restrooms is found will be assessed an excessive room cleaning fee.
5. Group will assign a liaison to meet daily with the Head of Housekeeping and hotel management to assure that all its members are complying with hotel rules. Any offenders will be asked to leave hotel immediately.
6. Dogs will not be permitted in any of the hotel recreation areas including the swimming pools, and any other areas to be stipulated as "non-dog" locations.
7. Dogs will not be permitted in food and beverage outlets, apart from those assisting the disabled.
8. The hotel will provide trash receptacles in the designated exercise areas for deposit of waste.
9. Group will provide plastic bags and appropriate scoops etc. for collection of waste through facility.
10. Pick up and removal of waste will be the responsibility of each dog owner/handler.
11. Group will appoint a Grounds Committee to continuously monitor all exercise areas to assure that members comply with the rules. If excessive amounts of waste are found to have not been removed, an excessive clean-up fee may be added to the final bill.
12. Convention Center doors must be closed during event hours for safety of the dogs. Royal Canin Ring/Holiday Inn Roberts Centre will take no responsibility to ensure doors remain closed.
13. Grooming will be in designated areas and will be available on a first-come, first-served basis.
14. Crates must be stacked whenever possible.
15. Absolutely NO exercise pens in the grooming area.
16. ALAC reserves the right to limit the space any one exhibitor or group claims for grooming.
17. There will be no security service on duty overnight. NO DOGS MAY BE LEFT IN THE GROOMING AREA OVERNIGHT. All dogs and equipment must be removed one hour after judging is completed on 10/17/26.
18. The American Lhasa Apso Club, the Royal Canin Ring/Holiday Inn Roberts Centre and/or the Event Secretaries, their officers, members or agents assume no responsibility for dogs or personal property left in the hotel facilities or parking lots.

### **DIRECTIONS TO ROBERTS CENTRE - WILMINGTON, INDIANA**

#### **From Dayton International Airport**

Head northeast on Terminal Drive toward Boeing Drive. Make a U-turn at Boeing Drive. Continue onto Dayton International Airport Access Road. Use the left two lanes to merge onto I-70 East via the ramp to Dayton. Merge onto I-70 East. Use the right two lanes to take exit 33A to merge onto I-75 South toward Dayton. Keep left to stay on I-75 South. Use the right two lanes to take exit 52 to merge onto US-35 East toward Xenia. Use any lane to turn slightly right onto the US-35 East ramp to Washington C H. Continue onto US-35 East. Take Exit 53 for US-68 toward Home Ave/Wilmington. Turn right onto US-68 South. Turn left onto Gano Road.

#### **From John Glenn Columbus International Airport**

Head east on International Gateway. Turn right. At the traffic circle, take the 2nd exit. Turn right onto International Gateway. Keep left to stay on International Gateway. Use the left lane to merge onto I-670 W/US-62 W via the ramp to Columbus. Merge onto I-670 W/US-62 W. Continue to follow I-670 W. Take exit 2A to merge onto OH-315 S. Use any lane to take the exit toward I-71 S. Use the left 2 lanes to merge onto I-71 S via the ramp to Cincinnati. Take exit 50 for US-68 toward Wilmington. Turn right onto US-68 N. Turn right at the 1st cross street onto Gano Rd.

Head north on Wilmer Avenue toward Ohio to Erie Trail. Continue onto Wilmer Avenue. Turn left onto Beechmont Circle. Turn left onto Wooster Road. Turn left onto Red Bank Road. Continue onto Red Bank Expressway. Slight right to merge onto I-71 N toward Columbus. Merge onto I-71 North. Take exit 50 for US-68 toward Xenia. Take left onto US-68 North. Turn right at the 2nd cross street onto Gano Road.

## **RV RULES FOR OVERNIGHT GUESTS**

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1. Roberts Centre will handle ALL RV Reservations and Individual Guests will be held responsible for maintenance of the parking lot as laid out below.
2. The Roberts Centre has 26 RV spots which are Full Hook-ups. These spots are charged at a rate of \$40 per night/all other parking is considered dry parking and is charged at a rate of \$25 per night. **GUESTS MUST PRE-REGISTER FOR RV PARKING.** RV availability is on a first-come, first-serve basis.
3. Payment: All checks must be payable to The Roberts Centre. You may also pay by credit card. Payment in full is required when reservations are made. Paid reservations must be received no later than two weeks before the event that you will be attending. No refunds will be issued after this date. All RV parking is on a pre-paid reservation basis.
4. Reserved Spot Assignments/Requirements: All spaces will be pre-assigned. "Holding" or changing spaces is not permitted. If you would like to be next to someone, please designate it on your reservation form. Reservation of additional RV Parking spaces is not permitted. This includes no cones, rope, string, other vehicles, x-pens mats, or any other means of reserving parking space. **RVs MUST NOT be parked within 6 feet of Roberts Road or in front of the area where the hookups begin – this is for guest safety and must be followed.**
5. One additional vehicle is permitted overnight per RV space reserved. No parking of any additional vehicles in your assigned space is permitted. All vehicles must be self-contained. Please be courteous when parking. Leave enough room for your slide outs, awnings and vehicle.
6. Cleaning and Maintenance of RV Spot Requirements: It is the individual guest's responsibility to ensure they are leaving their reserved RV Parking spot the way they found it without damaging the spot or leaving behind trash/waste. It is required that the guest dispose of all trash, waste, bedding, etc from the reserved RV spot prior to departure. If the guest required trash bags, they can be purchased from our front desk at \$1:00 per bag. Excess cleaning of the guest's reserved RV Spot after the guest has "checked-out" will result in an additional cleaning fee of a minimum of \$50. This amount may vary depending upon the amount of cleaning and/or damage to the reserved spot.

### Non-Regular Classes (Involving multiple dog entries)

Not offered for Sunshine State Lhasa Apso Club

*Note: Non-regular classes involving multiple entries may be judged before or after Best of Breed. As the judge's decision in these classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog, no one of the dogs making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed by virtue of having won the class.*

**Stud Dog Class and Brood Bitch Class:** Each entry is allowed a minimum of two and no more than six of their Get. The merits of the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch are not considered in the placement of the entry. It is the quality of the get that forms the basis for the judge's decision. All get must be examined and gaited. The Stud Dog or Brood Bitch must also be examined to determine if there is a condition that would require disqualification or excusal under the Rules, AKC policy or the breed standard. All get must be entered in a regular class in order to be eligible to compete in the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch Class. Handlers of the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch, and all get being exhibited, must wear armbands. Ch. 11, Sec. 8 of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that "a castrated male may be entered as a Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class."

**Brace Class:** Two Dogs, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in the brace class must have at least one common owner. Dogs do not need to be entered in any other class. Dogs comprising a Brace Class must be named at the time of entry, and full particulars must be given for each dog on individual entry forms. If a dog which is to be part of a Brace is not entered in another class, it must be entered for "Brace Class only." An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as part of a Brace must be marked accordingly in the space provided for additional classes as "Brace Class." If more than one Brace is entered by same owner, dogs comprising EACH BRACE must be designated "Brace No. 1," "Brace No. 2," etc.

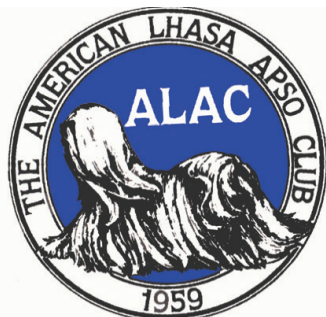

## **2026 ALAC FUTURITY/MATURITY COMPETITION**

### **2026 FUTURITY/MATURITY RULES**

**Futurity Eligibility:** The nomination of a litter is open to anyone who breeds a litter of Lhasa Apsos. A litter nomination must be made within 90 days of birth. Extensions can be made by contacting Laura Rock. Puppies born between April 16, 2025 and April 15, 2026 are eligible if nominated by August 31, 2026. Maturity dates are the same. Entrants must be over 18 months but less than 31 months on the date of the competition.

**Futurity and Maturity Entries:** All Lhasa Apsos entered in the futurity or maturity Must be entered in one or more of the regular classes at the ALAC National Specialty. The entry must be marked in the Additional Class section with "Futurity" or "Maturity" and the assigned futurity /maturity number. Entry into the Futurity or Maturity is FREE. The fees are paid by the Jan Bruton Memorial Fund.

Please note that entries without the Futurity or Maturity numbers are not acceptable for competition. Lhasas entered in the Maturity must have been nominated by the owner between 18 and 31 months with both a previous year's Futurity number and current Maturity number.

The exhibitor will be contacted & required to send a money order for the original amount PLUS the \$30.00 NSF fee. Subsequent returned checks from same person may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY BASIS.
- **REFUNDS** for cancellations due to judge change or cancellations made prior to entries closing will be mailed by the Club to said Exhibitor or Agent **AFTER THE SHOW.** An administrative fee of \$5.00 will be withheld from all refunds for entries cancelled prior to the closing of entries.
- Females in season are not permitted to compete in Obedience or Rally Trials. If a female is withdrawn from competition because it came into season and the Superintendent is notified no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class in the trial, the Club is required to refund the entry fee. The Clubs may retain a processing fee and must publish this information in the premium. Clubs may determine the documentation, if any that is required to confirm the female is in season. This shall be stated in the premium. Note: No fee is paid to the AKC for females in season who are withdrawn.
- **FAX ENTRIES** – Fax entries will not be accepted.
- Entry fees shall NOT be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. There is no refund for **DUPLICATE ENTRIES** or **OVERPAYMENTS**. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open, or to complete the Show **NO REFUND** will be made. To find out about any AKC event cancellations call the AKC Event Cancellation Hotline 877-252-3229.
- Please note: Any hotel or motel listed in the premium list is subject to Event Committee Rules. We expect our exhibitors to be responsible guests. A report that an exhibitor at this show has abused hotel or motel property during this weekend may result in disciplinary action. Clubs reserve the right to decline future entries from the offending party in accordance with the provisions of Ch. 11, Sec. 15 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows.
- Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging. Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Superintendent will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class Judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the rings.
- Only dogs eligible for these shows will be admitted into show area. There is no provision for unentered dogs.
- **LOSS OR DAMAGE** – The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of any accident or misfortune, to either dogs or exhibitors participating in these Shows. The welfare of an Exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the Exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that Exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. Additionally, clubs should include any specific local health requirements; for example proof of rabies vaccination.
- **PUBLICATION RIGHTS** – By entering this show, all owners, handlers, breeders and kennels agree that all rights to televise, videotape, photograph, advertise, promote and publicize or otherwise exploit this show, or the persons or animals participating in it or the results of the competition before, during or after the event, shall belong solely to The American Kennel Club and their respective assigns, including the use of the names, likenesses or biographical matter of all dogs, owners, handlers, breeders and kennels participating in the show and no such owner, handler, breeder or kennel shall allow any other party to make commercial use of any videotape or photograph of any person or animal participating in this competition.
