IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING SHOW SITE / HOTEL

HOLIDAY INN ROBERTS CENTRE RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. There shall be no more than four (4) dogs per room. All dogs left unattended in hotel guest rooms must be crated.
- Group must provide sheets of plastic to place under the crates. UP TO FOUR DOGS WILL BE PERMITTED PER ROOM. ALAC will provide the plastic.
- 3. Housekeepers will NOT have to service rooms in which dogs are loose and unattended. Moreover, they will be required to report this rules violation to hotel management. A one-time fee of \$75 will be charged for each room in which a dog is housed per stay. Rooms found to house a dog/animal that is not secured in a crate will be charged a higher pet fee. Individual room occupants will be assessed for any damage or destruction to that room including but not limited to damage to sheets, towels, flooring, furniture, carpet etc.
- 4. Dogs will be bathed in designed areas for dog washing. There will be no grooming of dogs in hotel rooms and no hotel towels will be used for that purpose. Rooms where evidence of dog grooming in the restrooms is found will be assessed an excessive room cleaning fee.
- Group will assign a liaison to meet daily with the Head of Housekeeping and hotel management to assure that all its members are complying with hotel rules. Any offenders will be asked to leave hotel immediately.
- 6. Dogs will not be permitted in any of the hotel recreation areas including the swimming pools, and any other areas to be stipulated as "non-dog" locations.
- 7. Dogs will not be permitted in food and beverage outlets, apart from those assisting the disabled.
- 8. The hotel will provide trash receptacles in the designated exercise areas for deposit of waste.
- 9. Group will provide plastic bags and appropriate scoops etc. for collection of waste through facility.
- 10. Pick up and removal of waste will be the responsibility of each dog owner/handler.
- 11. Group will appoint a Grounds Committee to continuously monitor all exercise areas to assure that members comply with the rules. If excessive amounts of waste are found to have not been removed, an excessive clean-up fee may be added to the final bill.
- 12. Convention Center doors must be closed during event hours for safety of the dogs. Royal Canin Ring/Holiday Inn Roberts Centre will take no responsibility to ensure doors remain closed.
- 13. Grooming will be in designated areas and will be available on a first-come, first-served basis.
- 14. Crates must be stacked whenever possible.
- 15. Absolutely NO exercise pens in the grooming area.
- 16. ALAC reserves the right to limit the space any one exhibitor or group claims for grooming
- There will be no security service on duty overnight. NO DOGS MAY BE LEFT IN THE GROOMING AREA OVERNIGHT. All dogs and equipment must be removed one hour after judging is completed on 10/30/25.

Spayed and neutered animals may be entered and shown in Veteran Classes at specialty shows. Winners of the Veterans Classes may also compete for Best of Breed Competition, provided that they are undefeated in any Regular Class at this show.

Non-Regular Classes (Involving multiple dog entries)

Not offered for Sunshine State Lhasa Apso Club

Note: Non-regular classes involving multiple entries may be judged before or after Best of Breed. As the judge's decision in these classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog, no one of the dogs making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed by virtue of having won the class.

Stud Dog Class and Brood Bitch Class: Each entry is allowed a minimum of two and no more than six of their Get. The merits of the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch are not considered in the placement of the entry. It is the quality of the get that forms the basis for the judge's decision. All get must be examined and gaited. The Stud Dog or Brood Bitch must also be examined to determine if there is a condition that would require disqualification or excusal under the Rules, AKC policy or the breed standard. All get must be entered in a regular class in order to be eligible to compete in the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch Class. Handlers of the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch, and all get being exhibited, must wear armbands. Ch. 11, Sec. 8 of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that "a castrated male may be entered as a Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class."

Brace Class: Two Dogs, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in the brace class must have at least one common owner. Dogs do not need to be entered in any other class. Dogs comprising a Brace Class must be named at the time of entry, and full particulars must be given for each dog on individual entry forms. If a dog which is to be part of a Brace is not entered in another class, it must be entered for "Brace Class only." An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as part of a Brace must be marked accordingly in the space provided for additional classes as "Brace Class." If more than one Brace is entered by same owner, dogs comprising EACH BRACE must be designated "Brace No. 1," "Brace No. 2," etc.



2025 ALAC FUTURITY/MATURITY COMPETITION

2025 FUTURITY/MATURITY RULES

Futurity Eligibility: The nomination of a litter is open to anyone who breeds a litter of Lhasa Apsos. A litter nomination must be made within 90 days of birth. Extensions can be made by contacting Laura Rock. Litters born between June 15, 2025, and September 30, 2025 nominated are eligible to enter the futurity.

Futurity and Maturity Entries: All Lhasa Apsos entered in the futurity or maturity Must be entered in one or more of the regular classes at the ALAC National Specialty. The entry must be marked in the Additional Class section with "Futurity" or "Maturity" and the assigned futurity /maturity number. Entry into the Futurity or Maturity is FREE. The fees are paid by the Jan Bruton Memorial Fund.

Please note that entries without the Futurity or Maturity numbers are not acceptable for competition. Lhasas entered in the Maturity must have been nominated by the owner between 18 and 31 months with both a previous year's Futurity number and current Maturity number.

ALL LHASA APSOS SHOWN IN THE FUTURITY OR MATURITY COMPETITION MUST BE HANDLED BY THEIR OWNER, A MEMBER OF THE OWNER'S HOUSEHOLD. THE BREEDER OR AMATEUR HANDLER.

The Futurity will be divided by sex and be judged in the following classes: Puppy 6 mos. and under 9 mos. Puppy 9 mos. and under 12 mos.

Winning Puppy in each class competes for Best Puppy in Futurity

Junior 12 mos. to 15 mos. Junior 15 mos. to 18 mos.

Winning Junior in each class competes for Best Junior in Futurity Best Puppy and Best Junior compete for Grand Futurity Winner.

The Maturity will be divided by sex and judged in the following classes:

Adult 18 mos. to 24 mos. Adult 24 mos. to 31 mos.

All class winners in Maturity compete for Best in Maturity and Best of Opposite Sex in Maturity.

Exhibitors, please note that the Futurity entry is free and open to Lhasa Apsos at least 6 months of age and under 18 months of age. Maturity entry is free and open to 18 months to 31 months and older on the day of the show. All Lhasa Apsos entered MUST also be entered in one of the regular classes and on the regular entry form.

AKC NATIONAL OWNER-HANDLED SERIES - ALL SPECIALTIES

This is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers. All dogs that are owner-handled and are not solely owned or exhibited by professional handlers* meet the requirements for this competition. Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry using the check box on the entry form. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the judge's book, steward's book & the catalog.

Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner*. Professional handlers, household members and assistants to current professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in any breed competition during the entire show.

*Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay or received payment for handling a dog within the last five years.

Entries into the Amateur-Owner-Handler class are automatically entered into the AKC NOHS and do not have to check the box on the entry form.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS - ALL EVENTS



The American Kennel Club Rules and Regulations will govern this Show and Exhibitors must make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany this Show Premium List. The American Kennel Club will collect the following at every Licensed or Member club event:

- First entry of a dog in Conformation or Obedience, a \$3.00 Event Service Fee and \$.50 Recording Fee, plus a \$3.50 Service Fee for each additional entry of the same dog. First entry and each additional entry of a dog in Agility or Rally. \$3.50 Service Fee.
- No Entry will be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Telegraph, e-mail and unsigned
 entries cannot be accepted and will be returned. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies of
 Entry Forms without Agreement and Rules on reverse side are NOT ACCEPTABLE. The Club and/or Baray Events
 assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or the
 owner's agent. RESPONSIBILITY FOR COMPLETENESS OF ENTRY RESTS SOLELY WITH ENTRANT.
- RETURNED CHECKS DO NOT CONSTITUTE A VALID ENTRY FEE. BaRay Events will add a \$30.00 collection fee
 to the amount of each returned check. We will not re-process checks. The exhibitor will be contacted & required
 to send a money order for the original amount PLUS the \$30.00 NSF fee. Subsequent returned checks from same
 person may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY BASIS.
- REFUNDS for cancellations due to judge change or cancellations made prior to entries closing will be mailed by
 the Club to said Exhibitor or Agent AFTER THE SHOW. An administrative fee of \$5.00 will be withheld from all
 refunds for entries cancelled prior to the closing of entries.
- Females in season are not permitted to compete in Obedience or Rally Trials. If a female is withdrawn from competition because it came into season and the Superintendent is notified no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class in the trial, the Club is required to refund the entry fee. The Clubs may retain a processing fee and must publish this information in the premium. Clubs may determine the documentation, if any that is required to confirm the female is in season. This shall be stated in the premium. Note: No fee is paid to the AKC for females in season who are withdrawn.
- · FAX ENTRIES Fax entries will not be accepted.
- Entry fees shall NOT be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the
 Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or because it has been
 entered incorrectly. There is no refund for DUPLICATE ENTRIES or OVERPAYMENTS. If, because of riots, civil

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION - ALL EVENTS

- **NOVICE CLASS:** This shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class.
- **OPEN CLASS:** For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three first place awards in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show.
- MASTER CLASS: This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have 10 Best Junior wins with competition.

After the judge has awarded the Best Junior Handler, the second place winner from the class that the Junior was awarded Best Junior Handler is to return to the ring to compete for Reserve Best Junior Handler.

NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry. You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC, Judges Education Department, 919-233-9767. BE SURE ALL INFORMATION for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on front and back of entry form.

NOTE: SUBSTITUTION OF DOG IN JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP AT THE SHOW(S): There will be an Administration Fee of \$5.00 charged for any substitution of dog in Junior Showmanship at each show. In addition, if the dog originally entered in Jr. Showmanship was an additional entry, and the dog being substituted is not otherwise entered in the show, the Junior Showmanship Only fee applies.

ATTENTION OWNERS/EXHIBITORS OF FOREIGN REGISTERED DOGS

If you are the owner/exhibitor of a dog registered with a foreign registry (not yet dual registered with AKC) please review the eligibility requirements in The Rules Applying to Dog Shows, chapter 11 section 1. The dog show rules are posted on the AKC Web site at: http://images.akc.org/pdf/rulebooks/RREGS3.pdf.

Most important to note are the following:

- 1. Dogs must be individually registered with the American Kennel Club by the day of the event to be eligible for exhibit in the Bred by Exhibitor class.
- 2. Dogs are eligible to compete in AKC events using the foreign registration for a period of 30 days. That 30-day period begins with the date of first exhibit, *regardless of whether the dog earned any points or awards*. To continue to compete in AKC events beyond the initial 30-day period the dog must be either individually AKC registered or by the date of the event have been granted an extension to exhibit using the foreign registration. The owner or agent can request an extension using the form found on the AKC Web site at: http://images.akc.org/pdf/extenap.pdf.
