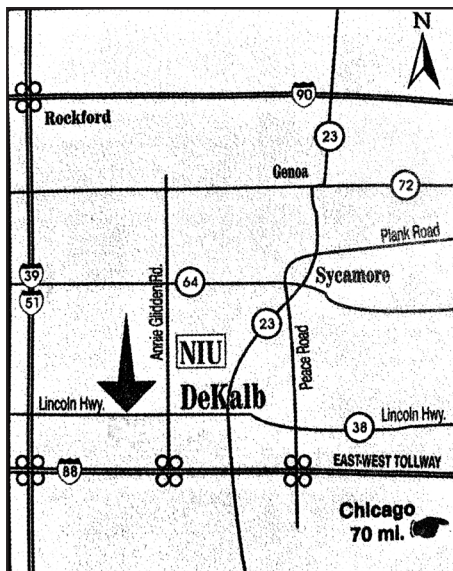

FROM NORTH OR SOUTH: From I-39, exit to I-88 East. Travel I-88 East to the Annie Glidden Road exit. From the Annie Glidden Road take Route 38 (Lincoln Highway). West to the Convocation Center entrance.

FROM EAST OR WEST: Take I-88 to Annie Glidden Road exit and follow directions above.

FROM I-90: Exit onto Route 47 South to Route 38 West approximately 20 miles to the Convocation Center entrance. See Map.

ACCOMMODATIONS

Please be respectful of hotel property and other guests. **There should be NO grooming or bathing of dogs at the hotel. ATTENTION OWNERS

GENERAL INFORMATION/RULES

- Site will be available Friday, April 4, 2026. The Building will be open to Vendors and Exhibitors at 2:00PM or when BaRay is done with setup on the upper level (NO EXCEPTIONS). The Building will be locked at 10:00PM on Friday, April 3, and Saturday, April 4, 2026. The Building will reopen at 6:30AM each day. All dogs and equipment must be removed from the show site following Best in Show on Sunday, April 5, 2026.
- **DOGS MAY NOT BE LEFT IN THE BUILDING OVERNIGHT!**
- BUILDING IS HANDICAPPED ACCESSIBLE TO MAIN FLOOR & GROOMING AREA.
- The management/Superintendent/Club or its members will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog on site or for possessions of any exhibitor, whether the result of an accident or any other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this show is in the care, custody and control of its owner, agent or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show grounds. Show Superintendent and the employees of the Club and/or the Superintendent, will not be liable for any loss or injury which may be sustained through loss, theft, injury and/ or death of dogs entered at these events, whether said loss, theft, injury and/or death is or are caused by the negligence or carelessness of the said Kennel Club, their members, directors, officers, agents, Superintendent or by negligence of any person or by any other cause.
- All grooming is indoors. Limited electric is available in several areas. Please share outlets.
- Grooming in designated areas only. Grooming areas will be monitored and supervised. The club reserves the right to restrict or consolidate grooming space.
- Crates and equipment must be stacked.
- No rugs or mats on the floor.
- Private exercise pens are NOT allowed in building. No ex-pens used as crates. This includes puppy/cocker/drop pens. Ample OUTSIDE exercise area is available and MUST be kept clean. Those individuals not picking up after their dogs will be subject to discipline.
- No saving of grooming or parking spaces. Tape, cords, rope and cones will be removed and become the property of the Kennel Club.
- In accordance with building regulations: NO materials may be taped, stapled, nailed, tacked etc. to the floors, walls, ceiling or posts.
- Limited crate space may be available on level of the main show rings. There is NO electric available on the show floor and NO dryers allowed.
- Each exhibitor is responsible for keeping their grooming area clean. Please bring a broom and keep the grooming area free of debris. Aisles must be kept clear.
- Exhibitors are reminded to honor "NO DOG" areas. Dogs are not allowed in the Convocation Center lobby, on the passenger elevator or on tiled floor areas. Dogs are allowed in the freight elevator.
- This is a handicapped accessible facility with elevator access. No dogs permitted on this elevator.
- FREIGHT ELEVATOR is available during hours posted by the University. Staircases are available all day.
- Unentered dogs are not allowed on the show grounds. Dogs in attendance solely for the health clinics should stay in the clinic area and leave the building following their scheduled appointment.
- All dogs must be on a leash except while in obedience competition or when on the table, crated, or in an exercise pen. Dogs left on the table or in an ex-pen MUST be properly supervised.
- No Flexi leads allowed in the building.
- No Double Handling.
- Please turn off cell phones and pagers in the ring area. No cell phones allowed in the rings.
- NO SMOKING at any time in the building.
- No strollers permitted.
- Children must be under the direct control and supervision of an adult guardian.
- Flyers, brochures or other advertising materials may not be placed or distributed without the permission of the show giving club. No solicitation.
- Permission to videotape must be requested of and granted by the Show Chairperson & Building Superintendent.
- Food Vendor on site. NO OUTSIDE FOOD WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE BUILDING.

AKC SANCTIONED 4-6 MONTHS PUPPY

Entries will close Wednesday Noon, March 18, 2026 at Superintendent's office.

The Four-to-Six Month Puppy competition shall be for dogs that are four months of age and over but under six months on the day of the event. Classes will be offered for breeds and varieties and divided into Groups as described in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows and the Miscellaneous Class breeds as listed in Chapter 3, Section 23. The Miscellaneous class competition will be the equivalent of Group competition and the winner will be eligible to compete in Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show. The FSS competition will be the equivalent of Group competition and the winner will be eligible to compete in Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show.

Entry and eligibility requirements include:

- AKC registration number or an AKC litter number will be required for entries of an AKC recognized breed as listed in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows.
- A foreign born dog may enter this class if it is registered in the country of origin.
- All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol.
- Professional handlers, members of their household and current assistants to professional handlers may personally exhibit a dog they own as "Exhibition Only" in the Four-to-Six Month (Beginner Puppy) Competition. Entries must be marked "Exhibition Only" prior to the close of entries. Exhibition-only entrants will participate in the same BPUP classes as regular entries. Judges will evaluate exhibition-only entrants in the same manner as regular entrants but will not consider them for awards. All Exhibition BPUP entries will receive an armband/catalog number starting with a capital "E."
- To be competitive, dogs that are owned or co-owned by a professional handler may compete in this class, but must be handled by a non-professional handler. Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs to or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants or household members of a professional handler. A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis, or, assisting a professional handler at the show or any show during the cluster/weekend. Minors (under 18) with amateur status who reside with professional handlers and current assistants to professional handlers that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age and amateur status requirements) may personally exhibit dogs in the Four-to-Six Month (Beginner Puppy) Competition.

USE OF RAMPS – ALL BREEDS

A judge requesting the use of a ramp must give notice to the show superintendent/show secretary prior to judging. AKC approval is not required. The entire entry in a breed is to be examined in the same manner (ground, table, or ramp).

At the discretion of the judge, the following breeds may be judged **on the ground or on a ramp** through all levels of competition: Nova Scotia Duck Tolling Retrievers, American Water Spaniels, Boykin Spaniels, Field Spaniels, Welsh Springer Spaniels, Grand Basset Griffon Vendéen, Norwegian Elkhounds, Whippets, German Pinschers, Portuguese Water Dogs, Standard Schnauzers, American Staffordshire Terriers, Irish Terriers, Soft Coated Wheaten Terriers, Staffordshire Bull Terriers, Finnish Spitz, Australian Cattle Dogs, Entlebucher Mountain Dogs, Finnish Lapphunds, Icelandic Sheepdogs, Norwegian Buhunds, Polish Lowland Sheepdogs, and Basset Fauve de Bretagne, Norrbottenspets (Misc.).

At the discretion of the judge through all levels of competition, the following breeds may be judged on a **ramp or table** through all levels of competition: Mudi, Puli.

At the discretion of the judge through all levels of competition, the following breeds may be judged on the **ground, ramp, or table** through all levels of competition: Miniature Bull Terriers.

The following breeds **must be judged on a ramp** through all levels of conformation competition: Lagotto Romagnolo, Clumber Spaniels, English Springer Spaniels, Sussex Spaniels, Basset Hounds, Cirneco dell'Etna, Kerry Blue Terriers, Bulldogs, Chinese Shar-Pei, Chow Chows, Keeshonden and Spanish Water Dogs.

This extends to all conformation competition at AKC conformation dog shows and any AKC event where a conformation title may be earned. This policy includes Group, BIS, Junior Showmanship, the 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy Competition, the AKC National Owner-Handled Series (NOHS), and all other special attractions that offer Group and BIS competitions. Ramps can be used in emergency situation to judge any breed.

In an emergency situation, where use of a ramp is not indicated in the premium list, an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund. For the judging of juniors the ramp may be used at the discretion of the judge for the ramp optional breeds. (01/2026)

- No Entry will be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Telegraph, e-mail and unsigned entries cannot be accepted and will be returned. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies of Entry Forms without Agreement and Rules on reverse side are NOT ACCEPTABLE. The Club and/or Baray Events assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or the owner's agent. JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

NOVICE CLASS: For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or member show.

OPEN CLASS: For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three first place awards in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show. Juniors which according to their records have completed the requirements to compete in the Open class but whose status is unconfirmed by the American Kennel Club are limited to competing in the Open Class for a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the Junior completed the requirements according to their records.

MASTER CLASS: This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

NOVICE AND OPEN Class divided: Junior-9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show; Intermediate-12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show; Senior-15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show.

RESERVE JUNIOR HANDLER: After the judge has awarded the Best Junior Handler, the second place winner from the class that the Junior was awarded Best Junior Handler is to return to the ring to compete for Reserve Best Junior Handler.

NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry. You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC, Judges Education Department, 919-233-9767. BE SURE ALL INFORMATION for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on front and back of entry form.

NOTE: SUBSTITUTION OF DOG IN JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP AT THE SHOW(S): There will be an Administration Fee of \$5.00 charged for any substitution of dog in Junior Showmanship at each show. In addition, if the dog originally entered in Jr. Showmanship was an additional entry, and the dog being substituted is not otherwise entered in the show, the Junior Showmanship Only fee applies.
