The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed Competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

AOM exclude the winners of Best of Breed and Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Select Dog, Select Bitch, and Best of Winners that, by virtue of their placements have already been recognized.
