NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS - ALL EVENTS

The American Kennel Club Rules and Regulations will govern this Show and Exhibitors must make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany this Show Premium List. The American Kennel Club will collect the following at every Licensed or Member club event: An AKC

Recording and Service Fee of \$4.50 for each entry. An AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 per entry will be required for each dog entered at any 4 & Under 6 Months Puppy and Open Show. All Recording and Event Service Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club. (There is no Recording Fee or Event Service Fee for Junior Showmanship, Sweepstakes, Futurities, Brace/Team, Multi-Dog Classes, or Special Attractions.)

- No Entry will be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Telegraph, e-mail and unsigned entries cannot be accepted and will be returned. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies of Entry Forms without Agreement and Rules on reverse side are NOT ACCEPTABLE. The Club and/or Baray Events assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or the owner's agent. RESPONSIBILITY FOR COMPLETENESS OF ENTRY RESTS SOLELY WITH ENTRANT.
- RETURNED CHECKS DO NOT CONSTITUTE A VALID ENTRY FEE. BaRay Events will add a \$30.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. We will not re-process checks. The exhibitor will be contacted & required to send a money order for the original amount PLUS the \$30.00 NSF fee. Subsequent returned checks from same person may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY BASIS.
- REFUNDS for cancellations due to judge change or cancellations made prior to entries closing will be mailed by the Club to said Exhibitor or Agent AFTER THE SHOW. An administrative fee of \$5.00 will be withheld from all refunds for entries cancelled prior to the closing of entries.
- Females in season are not permitted to compete in Obedience or Rally Trials. If a female is withdrawn from competition because it came into season and the Superintendent is notified no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class in the trial, the Club is required to refund the entry fee. The Clubs may retain a processing fee and must publish this information in the premium. Clubs may determine the documentation, if any that is required to confirm the female is in season. This shall be stated in the premium. Note: No fee is paid to the AKC for females in season who are withdrawn.
- FAX ENTRIES - Fax entries will not be accepted.
- Entry fees shall NOT be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. There is no refund for DUPLICATE ENTRIES or OVERPAYMENTS. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open, or to complete the Show NO REFUND will be made. To find out about any AKC event cancellations call the AKC Event Cancellation Hotline 877-252-3229.
- Please note: Any hotel or motel listed in the premium list is subject to Event Committee Rules. We expect our exhibitors to be responsible guests. A report that an exhibitor at this show has abused hotel or motel property during this weekend may result in disciplinary action. Clubs reserve the right to decline future entries from the offending party in accordance with the provisions of Ch. 11, Sec. 15 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows.
- Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging. Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Superintendent will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class Judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the rings.
- Only dogs eligible for these shows will be admitted into show area. There is no provision for unentered dogs.
- LOSS OR DAMAGE - The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of any accident or misfortune, to either dogs or exhibitors participating in these Shows. The welfare of an Exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the Exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that Exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. Additionally, clubs should include any specific local health requirements; for example proof of rabies vaccination.
- PUBLICATION RIGHTS - By entering this show, all owners, handlers, breeders and kennels agree that all rights to televise, videotape, photograph, advertise, promote and publicize or otherwise exploit this show, or the persons or animals participating in it or the results of the competition before, during or after the event, shall belong solely to The American Kennel Club and their respective assigns, including the use of the names, likenesses or biographical matter of all dogs, owners, handlers, breeders and kennels participating in the show and no such owner, handler, breeder or kennel shall allow any other party to make commercial use of any videotape or photograph of any person or animal participating in this competition.

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers. Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry on the entry form.

Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years.

A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis, or assisting a professional handler at the show or any time during the cluster/weekend. Current assistants that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age & amateur status requirements) may participate in NOHS.

Bred By Exhibitor Class Eligibility:

SECTION 8. The Bred-by-Exhibitor Class shall be for dogs that are: Six months of age or older as of the first day of the show; Not Champions on the date of closing of entries for the show; Individually registered with The American Kennel Club as of the date of the show; Owned or co-owned by any of the breeders of record as of the date of the show. The person handling the dog in this class must be a breeder of record and an owner of record of this dog. In any subsequent classes for which a dog from the Bred-by-Exhibitor class becomes eligible, there are no restrictions as to who may handle.

Amateur-Owner-Handled Class Eligibility:

Chapter 3, Section 7 - The Amateur-Owner-Handled class shall be for dogs that are at least six months of age that are not champions. Dogs must be handled in the class by the registered owner of the dog. This class is restricted to exhibitors who have not, at any point in time, been a professional dog handler, AKC approved conformation judge, or employed as an assistant to a professional handler. Additionally, members of the immediate family or household of a current professional handler are ineligible for this class (as defined in Chapter 11, Section 13).

RESERVE WINNERS - DOG & BITCH

The ACKCSC, as provided by the AKC, will designate the Reserve Winners Dog and the Reserve Winners Bitch to be awarded a three (3) point major, provided that the number of dogs competing in the regular classes of the Reserve Winners sex totals at least twice the number required for a five (5) point major in the region in which this event is held. No Major for Reserve Winners shall be given based upon an award of Best of Winners. In counting the number of dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, or that is dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge, or from which all awards are withheld, shall not be included.

Chapter 11 Section 8 Rules applying to Dog Shows provide that a neutered male or spayed bitch may be entered as a veteran. Winners of the above classes are eligible to compete in Best of Breed.

BEST OF BREED

(No defeated dogs will be allowed to compete)

The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed: Dogs that are Champions of record. Dogs which according to their owner's records have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed. The entry and showing of dogs whose championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a championship according to the owner's records. If, at the end of the 90 day period, the championship of a dog has not been confirmed by the AKC, no further entries of the dog for Best of Breed competition are to be made until championship has been confirmed by the AKC.. *To be followed by NOHS, Awards of Merit, Best Bred-By Exhibitor, Best Puppy & Best Veteran (see Page 12 for Special Recognition information)*

NON REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES (NATIONAL SPECIALTY ONLY)

As the judge's decision in the Non-Regular classes involving multiple entries is based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.

Stud Dog and Brood Bitch classes will be for stud dogs/brood bitches and two (2) of their get/produce. Stud dogs/brood bitches must be entered in the Stud Dog/Brood Bitch class and must be shown in the ring with their get/produce. The owner of the stud dog/brood bitch does not need to be the owner of the get/produce. The award is based upon the merits of the get/produce. The stud dog/brood bitch must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under Dog Show Rules, AKC Policy, or the standard for its breed. Get/produce must be entered in a Regular class and wear armbands

Stud Dog/Brood Bitch Class: For dogs and bitches that have sired/whelped two dogs or bitches entered in this show.

Brace Class: Two Dogs, (a unit), performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in the brace class must have at least one common owner. Dogs do not need to be entered in any other class. Dogs comprising a Brace Class must be named at the time of entry, and full particulars must be given for each dog on individual entry forms. If a dog which is to be part of a Brace is not entered in another class, it must be entered for "Brace Class only." An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as part of a Brace must be marked accordingly in the space provided for additional classes as "Brace Class."

SPECIAL RECOGNITION

Eligibility for Best Bred-By Exhibitor, Best Puppy, and Best Veteran competitions is predicated upon entry into the following class(es) and all divisions of:

- Best Bred-By Exhibitor - the Bred-by-Exhibitor class including the Bred-by-Exhibitor Puppy and Bred-by-Exhibitor Adult age divisions.
- Best Puppy - any class limited to dogs six months and older and under 12 months of age; 6-9 Puppy, 9-12 Puppy, and Bred-by-Exhibitor Puppy.
- Best Veteran - any non-regular Veteran Class.

For Best Bred-By Exhibitor, the eligibility criteria involving the individual handling the dog applies only to the original class entered and all competition specific to the special attraction (i.e., BBE Groups and BBE BIS). There are no restrictions as to who may handle the dog in any subsequent classes it may become eligible.

NOTE: Best Veteran, Best Puppy or Best Bred By Exhibitor competition will be forgone if the Best of Breed is one of the above.

AWARD OF MERIT (National Specialty) - At his/her discretion, the judge may award an Award of Merit to a maximum of 10% of the Best of Breed entry.

AWARD OF MERIT (Independent Specialty) - At his/her discretion, the judge may award an Award of Merit to a maximum of 4 entries.

Description: This seminar provides history, form and function of the breed, and an in-depth analysis of the Breed Standard. Our presentation is 90 minutes in length with additional time allowed for questions and answers. It will include a PowerPoint Presentation given by licensed judge and long-time breeder - Cindy Huggins. Additional materials available to attendees will be a photocopy of the PPT, Annotated Standard, Trifold and a Judges Quick Reference. Workshop will be 30 minutes with at least six (6) Cavaliers for attendees to have "hands on examination." Ringside Mentoring will follow seminar and workshop. We try to have at least one example of each of the four colors of Cavaliers present for illustration and examination. Participants receive a copy of our illustrated Breed Guide, an excellent reference for anyone judging the breed or who would like a deeper understanding of the breed and breed standard. Light food and beverages included. Ringside Mentoring will follow seminar and workshop. Ringside Mentoring will also be available on Thursday, April 16, 2026, for the judging of Best of Breed.

AKC SANCTIONED 4-6 MONTHS PUPPY - GROUPS OR ALL-BREED

Entries will close Wednesday Noon, March 18, 2026 at Superintendent's office.

The Four-to-Six Month Puppy competition shall be for dogs that are four months of age and over but under six months on the day of the event. Classes will be offered for breeds and varieties and divided into Groups as described in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows and the Miscellaneous Class breeds as listed in Chapter 3, Section 23. The Miscellaneous class competition will be the equivalent of Group competition and the winner will be eligible to compete in Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show. The FSS competition will be the equivalent of Group competition and the winner will be eligible to compete in Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show. Entry and eligibility requirements include:

- AKC registration number or an AKC litter number will be required for entries of an AKC recognized breed as listed in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows.
- A foreign born dog may enter this class if it is registered in the country of origin.
- All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol.
- Professional handlers, members of their household and current assistants to professional handlers may personally exhibit a dog they own as "Exhibition Only" in the Four-to-Six Month (Beginner Puppy) Competition. Entries must be marked "Exhibition Only" prior to the close of entries. Exhibition-only entrants will participate in the same BPUP classes as regular entries. Judges will evaluate exhibition-only entrants in the same manner as regular entrants but will not consider them for awards. All Exhibition BPUP entries will receive an armband/catalog number starting with a capital "E."
- To be competitive, dogs that are owned or co-owned by a professional handler may compete in this class, but must be handled by a non-professional handler. Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants or household members of a professional handler. A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis, or, assisting a professional handler at the show or any show during the cluster/weekend. Minors (under 18) with amateur status who reside with professional handlers and current assistants to professional handlers that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age and amateur status requirements) may personally exhibit dogs in the Four-to-Six Month (Beginner Puppy) Competition.

NOVICE CLASS: For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or member show.

OPEN CLASS: For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three first place awards in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show. Juniors which according to their records have completed the requirements to compete in the Open class but whose status is unconfirmed by the American Kennel Club are limited to competing in the Open Class for a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the Junior completed the requirements according to their records.

MASTER CLASS: This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

After the judge has awarded the Best Junior Handler, the second place winner from the class that the Junior was awarded Best Junior Handler is to return to the ring to compete for Reserve Best Junior Handler.

NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry. You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC, Judges Education Department, 919-233-9767. BE SURE ALL INFORMATION for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on front and back of entry form.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP PRIZES

Best Junior Handler: The ACKCSC will offer a prize for Best Junior Handler. The Junior Handler who has placed first in each regular Junior Showmanship Class, if undefeated in any other Junior Showmanship Class, shall automatically be eligible to compete for this prize.

Reserve Best Junior Handler: The ACKCSC will offer a prize for the Reserve Best Junior Handler. After the judge has awarded Best Junior Handler, the second place winner from the class that the Junior was awarded Best Junior Handler is to return to the ring to compete for Reserve Best Junior Handler with the remaining eligible class winners.

The following eligibility rules for entry are being observed during this event: All entries must have met the nomination deadlines as set forth in previous notices issued by the ACKCSC Futurity Stakes Committee. All entries must also be entered into a regular conformation/performance class to remain eligible for futurity stakes. All entries must be shown by their duly AKC registered owner(s) or breeder(s).

MONETARY AWARDS

There will be 35 cash wins: Three (3) individuals (breeder, owner, and owner of the sire at time of nomination) partaking of these awards for a total of 72 monetary awards, won by 32 different Cavaliers.

- Twenty percent (20%) shall be deducted from the total nomination pool and entry fee purse to be used for "Futurity Stakes" expenses. This will be known as the General Expense Fund. The fund shall be used to cover expenses incurred by the Futurity Stakes, i.e. judges, printing, mailing, etc... Since the administrative and judging expense will vary from year to year, an excess of funds in any given year shall be carried forward to use in future years for Futurity Stakes only. The remaining funds will be known as the "Total Purse".
- Twenty-five percent (25%) shall be deducted from the total purse and is to be awarded as follows: 15% to the Best in Futurity, 5% to the Best Senior in Futurity and 5% to the Best Junior in Futurity. The 15% of the Best in Futurity shall be divided – 50% to the recorded breeder of the winner, 50% to the recorded owner(s) of the winner. The 5% awarded to the Best Senior and Best Junior in Futurity is to be divided – 50% to the recorded breeder, 30% to the recorded owner(s) and 20% to the owner of the sire or owner of the semen at the time of mating, for each winner.
- The remaining seventy-five percent (75%) of the total purse shall be divided according to the percentage of the total entry represented by the number of Cavaliers entered in each class. As an example: Total Futurity Stakes entry = 100, entry in 6-9 mos. Bitches = 10; therefore 10/100 = 10%. As a result – 10% of the remaining purse is awarded in the 6-9 mos. bitch class.
- Rosettes shall be awarded for placements of First – Fourth place in each class. Additionally, Rosettes shall be given to the Best in Futurity, Best Senior in Futurity and Best Junior in Futurity. The cost for each will be covered from the General Expense Fund or through sponsorship.
- Monetary awards which are provided at the time of the National Specialty but are not claimed during that period shall be applied to the Total Futurity Stake for the following year.
