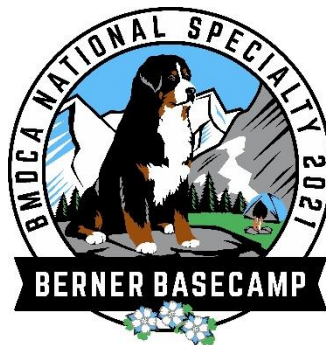

A trial program/schedule will be mailed to each entrant as soon as practical after closing of entries. For information concerning entries, contact Trial Secretary via phone or email (see front page).

Canadian exhibitors must submit entries with checks drawn on U.S. accounts or with Inter-national money orders in U.S. funds.

Entry fee will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, (unless replaced by an alternate), disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.

Entry fee's will be refunded if these events are canceled due to Covid 19 restrictions.

Post Dated Checks & Returned Checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Trial Secretary will add a \$25.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.

Bitches in season will run in catalog order for trial and at end of tests.

Please notify the Trial Secretary at the beginning of the event if you have a bitch in season.

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.

No entry fees will be refunded if the Trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes and/or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or the Trial Secretary.

Entries will not be accepted without fees or signatures. There will be **no refunds** for duplicate entries. Changes, additions or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing, fax or by email prior to close of entries. Those received by telephone are not acceptable.

No dog wrongly entered in a class may be transferred to another class nor can a dog be withdrawn after entries have closed for a refund unless there is a waitlist/alternate that can fill that entry. The owner or agent assumes all responsibilities for wrong or incomplete information of the entry blank.

EXHIBITOR INFORMATION:

No Un-entered dogs (*except set-out dogs) will be allowed at the test/trial site. All dogs present must be held on leash or otherwise restricted except when working stock. Under NO circumstances will dogs be allowed to disturb the resting stock or interfere from outside the arena with another dog's performance in the arena. Any dogs aggressive to person or stock will be removed. (See Chapter 1, Section 20 of the American Kennel Club Herding Regulations)

All AKC rules regarding conduct will be strictly enforced.

Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the Club nor its Trial Secretary will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents on progression of Judging. **Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs at the trial site and appropriate arena.**

The trial hosting Club, the Trial Secretary, their agents, employees, etc. assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property while at or on the trial grounds, or in transit to or from the trial. And furthermore assumes no responsibility for injury to children.

The hosting club will exercise every precaution for the safety of dogs exhibited, but it must be understood that neither the club, site or Trial secretary will be responsible for any injury, damage, or loss. It is understood that all dogs at this trial are in the care and custody of the owners or owner's agents during the entire trial weekend.

There shall be no drilling or intensive /abusive training of dogs on the Trial grounds.

Exhibitors are required to clean up after the dogs that they are trialing or which are under their care or control. This requirement includes both while in the arena or at any location on our trial site. Clean up tools and supplies will be available, see Trial Secretary if needed.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian recommendations to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.

Parents are solely responsible for their children and are expected to keep them supervised and controlled at all times, for their own safety.

All regulations governing the use of this facility, and all regulations and decisions of the Trial Committees of these trial giving clubs on this day will be strictly enforced, including and not recorded in this Premium List.

All persons entering this dog trial/event, hereby waive any claim for damages against the Bernese Mountain Dog Club of America, it's members or the Trial secretary in the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or suffocation due to improper ventilation. The club(s) is solely responsible for determining if the said animal is in distress.

Guidelines and Requirements

The following plan is prepared according to the state and local rules in force at the time of the event and is subject to change. The requirements/guidelines will be posted at the venue as well as on the BMDCA 2021 National Specialty website. Failure to comply could subject the individual to being removed from the grounds and/or disciplinary action in accordance with AKC's Dealing with Misconduct rules.

- All attendees (judges, exhibitors, stewards, workers, spectators, etc.) must follow state, local, and facility requirements/guidelines in effect at the time of this event.
- Mandatory temperature checks will be administered daily for each first entry to all indoor events.
- IF YOU ARE ILL, FEEL UNWELL, COUGHING, SNEEZING, RUNNING A TEMPERATURE, OR BELIEVE YOU HAVE BEEN EXPOSED (OR MAY HAVE BEEN EXPOSED) TO ANYONE WITH COVID-19 WITHIN THE LAST TWO WEEKS, PLEASE STAY HOME.
- Masks are MANDATORY - in the ring, upon entering the show grounds, and at all scheduled events. This includes the outdoor events – Draft, Tracking, Herding, and Scent Work. Nose and mouth must be covered. It is recommended for all other times. A face shield is NOT acceptable. The ONLY exceptions to this requirement will be for eating or drinking or for children aged 10 and younger.
- All attendees are expected to adhere to social distancing guidelines, even when wearing a mask.
- Ring access will be limited to exhibitors, please arrive at the ring no earlier than 15 minutes before your specified judging time and leave 15 minutes after. Rings will have a separate entrance and exit. Please use accordingly.
- Follow Judge's, Ring Steward's, and Show Committee's direction for showing and keeping distances.
- Social distancing will be required in all Grooming areas, please use crates and supplies as distance barriers. Forced air dryers and fans may be restricted in the grooming building. This will be determined based on the State defined published risk level at the time.
- The AKC, BaRay, Inc., all show giving clubs, volunteers, Estes Park Events Center, workers, or judges, are in no way liable for any present or future damage, loss, or illness (including, but not limited to COVID-19), Attendees understand that they are attending these shows entirely at their own risk and take full responsibility for their own health and safety. Attendees will be required to follow all State, County, AKC and club requirements, procedures, protocols, and guidelines to reduce any exposure and possibility of contracting or spreading a virus. All attendees MUST SIGN the COVID AGREEMENT/WAIVER OF LIABILITY prior to entrance to the event. If you are going through Master Registration, you will complete the waiver at that time.
